



## Foster Agreement

### FOSTER PROCESS

Thank you for contacting WAGS about becoming a dedicated foster! This is a very important part of an animal's adoption journey that allows them to recuperate from the shelter environment and showcase their adoptability in a comfortable and loving temporary home.

In addition to the completed application, we will check your references including your regular veterinarian, other rescues you are affiliated with, and landlord approval, as applicable. A home visit/phone interview may be done after references are checked. Once you have been notified that you have been approved, arrangements will be made with you to pick up the animal from a WAGS coordinator. At this time you will be given the supplies the animal needs including food, a leash and collar, and medications if necessary. It is your responsibility to contact the rescue when you need more supplies for the animal.

### YOU AS A FOSTER

You must be 21 years old or have written parental approval to foster a WAGS animal. WAGS does not place animals into homes whose pets are not up to date on vaccines, spayed/neutered, and on a heart-worm preventative. Documentation of each is necessary prior to placement into foster care. You are required to bring the animal to every scheduled vet appointment as well as notify the rescue if the animal exhibits any behavior deemed abnormal including excessive diarrhea or vomiting, lethargy, lack of appetite, or any other behavior indicative of illness.

### BY SUBMITTING THIS APPLICATION, YOU AGREE TO:

- All sections of the foster contract as outlined above.
- That the animal **MUST** be kept indoors and will not be chained or penned outside.
- That the animal will not be used in any illegal activities.
- That the animal is property of WAGS at all times and WAGS reserves the right to pull the animal out of foster for any reason at any time.

I have read all of the above information carefully and have completed this application honestly and to the best of my ability. I understand that omission of information and/or failure to answer all questions and sign the application can result in this application being declined. Also, if an omission or untruth is discovered after the placement takes place, I understand that WAGS reserves the right to remove the animal from the home. If the application passes review, I agree to a home and yard visit or a phone interview on a mutually agreed date by a WAGS coordinator before placement of the animal is made. In addition, I agree to comply with the adoption process and surrender the animal at the time of adoption.
